



# 2023 Site Rates and Fees

Season starts on May 15 at 12:00 PM and ends Sept. 30 at 3:00 PM

Rates based on two adults, two children under 18, living in same house, 1 RV camper, up to 2 vehicles.

Full hookup sites include water, sewer and electric service (50/30/20 amp, 120/240 volt).

Check-in time is 2 pm. Check-out time is noon. **Proof of rabies vaccination is required for dogs, cats or ferrets.**

## Day

- Tent – Primitive or W/E .....\$45
- RV - Full Hookup Campsite (W/E/S or W/E/DS).....\$50
- Minimum deposit to secure (1<sup>st</sup> night); payment in full due 2 weeks prior to stay ..... \$45/\$50

## Week

- Tent – Primitive or W/E ..... (two-week maximum stay for tents) .....\$275
- RV - Full Hookup Campsite (W/E/S or W/E/DS).....\$300
- Extra Person Each Per Week (no charge for children 5 and under) .....\$54
- Minimum deposit to secure; payment in full due 2 weeks prior to stay.....\$75

## Monthly

- Water/Electric Only ..... (ex. pop-ups, truck campers) .....\$1,000
- With Water/Sewer/Electric .....\$1,100
- Extra Person Each (no charge for children 5 and under) .....\$165
- Minimum deposit to secure; payment in full due 2 weeks prior to stay.....\$150

## Visitors

- Day Visitors, Per Person ..... **9 am to 8 pm** (plus overnight fee after 8pm) .....\$6
- Overnight Visitors, Per Person ..... **2 pm to 10 am** (plus daytime fee before 2 pm or after 10 am) .....\$12

(All visitors must register at office upon arrival. No charge for children 5 and under.

Visitors may NOT bring pets. Maximum 2 cars per site if there is room.)

**Dump Station:** \$20 per use – located at entrance to campground across from dog park (office needs to turn water on for guest use - and back off again when finished)

## 2023 Booking Policies

Minimum deposits as defined under our Site Rates and Fees list are required to secure all reservations. Payment in full is due two weeks prior to your stay.

If you need to cancel your reservation, please call the campground office at (603) 659-5051 during business hours. Email cancellations are not accepted.

**Refunds.** With the exception of seasonal bookings and holiday weekends, reservations may be cancelled up to two weeks (14 days) prior to scheduled arrival for a full refund less 50% of the minimum deposit amount. Thirteen (13) days to three (3) days prior to arrival, the full minimum deposit will be charged or credit toward a future stay will be offered. The full fee will be charged in the event of a “no show” or if a guest gives less than two (2) days’ notice prior to arrival.

Camping is an outdoor experience. No refunds or credits are provided due to the discomfort of nature. No refunds or credits for early departures.

**Minimum Stays.** A three-night minimum stay is required for Memorial Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day weekends. Holiday reservation deposits are non-refundable. A minimum stay of two nights is required for all other weekend reservations, to include either Friday/Saturday or Saturday/Sunday.

**Maximum Stays.** Tent camping is subject to a two-week maximum reservation. Should you wish to return and continue camping with us, a full week interval is required between bookings.

**Check-In and Check-Out Times.** Check-in time is 2:00 pm or later. Check-out time must occur before 12:00 pm (noon) on the day of departure. If you wish to arrive before 2:00 pm please check with the, you may pay a \$20.00 early check-in fee if available. If your site is available and you would like to stay until 4:00 pm you may pay a \$20.00 late checkout fee. Please submit your car pass to the office upon final departure. If you would like to register for additional nights, please do so by 10:00 am.

The season is May 15<sup>th</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>. The office is staffed from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm daily May through Labor Day Weekend, and from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm daily after Labor Day. We do not offer after-hours check-in. If you are unavoidably detained, please be sure to notify the office as soon as possible. Our primary concern is for your safety and comfort, as well as the peaceful enjoyment of all our campers.

**Reserving a Campsite (603) 659-5051.** Please have the following information in hand before you call.

- Dates you wish to reserve.
- Type of campsite needed (tent or RV).
- If RV, type and size/length of the RV you will be using.
- Name, address, cell phone number, email address (recommended).
- Number of adults, children in your camping party along with names and ages.
- Number of pets, if any. Note that proof of rabies vaccination will be required.
- Vehicle descriptions and license plate numbers for all vehicles, drivers license numbers for drivers.
- Debit/credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover or Amex).



# 2023 Seasonal Site Rates and Fees

Rates based on two adults, two children under 18, living in same house, 1 RV camper, up to 2 vehicles.  
Full hookup sites include water, sewer and electric service (50/30/20 amp, 120/240 volt).

**Proof of rabies vaccination is required for dogs, cats or ferrets.**

## Seasonal

(Seasonal camping is open to self-contained RVs only\*.)

- Standard Seasonal.....**\$2,800 plus electric**
- Premium Seasonal (riverside full hookups) .....**\$3,300 plus electric**
- Extra Person Each (for seasonal guests only – see seasonal agreement for details) .....**\$200**
- Extra Vehicle (over two) Per Day .....**\$5**

## Seasonal Deposit

- Due on or before September 30th (last day of season) .....**\$600**
- **Seasonal deposit is non-refundable after January 1<sup>st</sup>.**
- Balance of seasonal rate is **DUE IN FULL** on or before opening day, May 15.
- A **\$50** late fee will apply after opening day. Campers who have not paid in full by **June 1<sup>st</sup>** will be moved to the monthly rate or asked to leave the campground.

## Winter Storage

- Winter storage Per RV camper (for seasonal guests only) .....**\$200**  
RVs may be stored on site or in the field.

A signed Seasonal Camping Agreement is required at time of reservation. The season is May 15<sup>th</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>. The office is staffed from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm daily May through Labor Day Weekend, and from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm daily after Labor Day. Seasonal campers may arrive as early as 9 am on May 15<sup>th</sup>. We do not offer after-hours check-in. If you are unavoidably detained, please be sure to notify the office as soon as possible. Our primary concern is for your safety and comfort, as well as the peaceful enjoyment of all our campers.
