

2025 Site Rates and Fees

Season starts on May 15 at 12:00 PM and ends Sept. 30 at 3:00 PM

Rates are based on two adults, two children under 18, living in same house, 1 RV camper, up to 2 vehicles. Full hookup sites include water, sewer and electric service (50/30/20 amp, 120/240 volt).

Check-in time is 2 pm. Check-out time is noon. *Proof of rabies vaccination is required for dogs, cats or ferrets.*

- *Extra Children age 6 to 17 \$10.00 per day (no charge for children 5 and under)
- **Extra Adults 18+ \$12.00 per day.
- ***We reserve the right to limit the number of guests on all sites, including the number of Tents per site.

All RVs must have a valid and legal registration and display valid plates each year.

Charging of all Electric Vehicles (EVs) is strictly prohibited within the campground.

2025 Booking Policies

Minimum deposits as defined under our Site Rates and Fees list are required to secure all reservations. Payment in full is due two weeks prior to your stay and when booking any holiday weekend. If you need to cancel your reservation, please call the campground office at (603) 659-5051 during business hours. Email cancellations are not accepted.

Refunds: No refunds for seasonal bookings or holiday weekends.

All cancellations are subject to a \$25.00 cancellation fee.

Cancellations made **more than two weeks (14 days) prior** to scheduled arrival will receive a full refund of deposit less a **\$25.00 cancellation fee** or a credit toward a future stay will be offered.

Cancellations made **less than two weeks (14 days) prior** to scheduled arrival will **NOT** receive a refund. The full fee will be charged in the event of a "no show" with no refund. *Camping is an outdoor experience. No refunds or credits are provided due to the discomfort of nature. Minimum Stays: A three-night minimum stay is required for Memorial Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day weekends. Holiday reservations must be prepaid in full and are non-refundable. A minimum stay of two nights is required for all other weekend reservations, to include either Friday/Saturday or Saturday/Sunday.

Maximum Stays: Tent camping is subject to a <u>two-week maximum</u> reservation. Should you wish to return and continue camping with us, a full week (7 nights) interval is required between bookings.

Check-In and Check-Out Times: Check-in time is 2:00 pm or later. Check-out time must occur before 12:00 pm (noon) on the day of departure. If you wish to arrive before 2:00 pm please check with the office, you may pay a \$20.00 early check-in fee if available. If your site is available and you would like to stay until 4:00 pm you may pay a \$20.00 late checkout fee. Please submit your gate pass to the office upon final departure. If you would like to register for additional nights, if available, please do so by 10:00 am.

The season is from May 15th through September 30th. The office is staffed from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm daily May through Labor Day Weekend, and from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm daily after Labor Day. Reserving a Campsite (603) 659-5051. Please have the following information in hand before you call.

- Dates you wish to reserve.
- Type of campsite needed (tent or RV).
- If RV, type and size/length of the RV you will be using.
- Name, address, cell phone number, email address (recommended).
- Number of adults and children in your camping party along with names and ages.
- Number of pets, if any. Note that proof of rabies vaccination will be required.
- Vehicle descriptions and license plate numbers for all vehicles, driver's license numbers for drivers.
- Debit/credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover or Amex.)

Seasonal Deposit

- o Due on or before September 30th (last day of season)......\$600
- Seasonal deposit is non-refundable after January 1st.
- Balance of seasonal rate is **DUE IN FULL** on or before opening day, May 15.
- A **\$50** late fee will apply after opening day. Campers who have not paid in full by **June 1**st will be moved to the monthly rate or asked to leave the campground.

Winter Storage

Winter storage Per RV camper (for seasonal guests only)......\$200
RVs may be stored on site or in the field.

A signed Seasonal Camping Agreement is required at time of reservation. The season is from May 15th through September 30th. The office is staffed from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm daily May through Labor Day Weekend, and from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm daily after Labor Day. Seasonal campers may arrive as early as 9 am on May 15th. We do not offer after-hours check-in. If you are unavoidably detained, please be sure to notify the office as soon as possible. Our primary concern is for your safety and comfort, as well as the peaceful enjoyment of all our campers.

*All RVs must have a valid and legal registration and display valid plates each year. If you do not register your RV you will be taxed by the Town of Lee, N.H. twice per year. You will be responsible for providing documentation to the town that your RV holds an active registration and plate for each subsequent year. Temporary paper plates are not allowed after they expire.

* See Seasonal Camping Agreement for complete list of requirements, including 12 years or newer, insurance, etc. All RV's aged 12 years or older are subject to campground inspection and approval with all systems working (plumbing, electrical) and must be in good working order, no ripped awnings, screens, broken windows or use of tarps.
